## Abbreviations \& Material

sc = single crochet
slpst = slipstitch
dc = double crochet
hdc = half double crochet
tc $=$ treble crochet

* = repeat until end of round/row
( ) = number of stitches
- polyfill
- strong wire, 30-40 cm long
- piece of cardboard or strong plastic, $6 \times 6 \mathrm{~cm}$
- small stones or rice to fill the pot with ( the kind you use for rice pudding is perfect)
- Eyes, 8 mm glass eyes for zombieflower
- beads or any other decoration material you like to trim the pot with


## Leaves (make 2)

use green yarn
chain 2
6 sc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ from hook
Rnd 1: * sc around
Rnd 2: *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (9)
Rnd 3: * sc around
Rnd 4: *sc in next 2, 2 sc in next st (12)
Rnds 5-7: * sc around
Rnd 8: * sc in next 2, sc2tog (9)
Rnd 9: * sc around
Rnd 10: * sc in next st, sc2tog (6)
chain 1, flatten leaf und crochet 3 sc through both layers of round 10 end with a slpst
Caulis and back of the blossom
use green yarn (leave long end for sewing)
chain 2
6 sc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ from hook
Rnds 1-8: * sc around join leaves with 3 sc each
Rnds 9-24: * sc around
change to pink yarn
Rnd 25: 2 sc in each st around (12)
Rnd 26: *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18)
Rnd 27: *sc in next 2, 2 sc in next st (24)
Rnd 28: *sc in next 3, 2 sc in next st (30)
Rnd 29: *sc in next 4, 2 sc in next st (36)
Rnd 30: *sc in next 5, 2 sc in next st (42)
Rnd 31: *sc in next 6, 2 sc in next st (48)


Rnd 32: *sc in next 7, 2 sc in next st (54)
Rnd 33: * skip 1 st, in next st: $1 \mathrm{hdc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{tc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{hdc}$ skip 1 and slpst in next st

End with a slpst, bind off and leave long end for sewing. Insert wire into the caulis, form a ring and sew to back side of the blossom to secure.

## Face/front of the blossom

use white yarn
chain 2
6 sc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ from hook
Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)
Rnd 2: *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18)
Rnd 3: *sc in next 2, 2 sc in next st (24)
Rnd 4: *sc in next 3, 2 sc in next st (30)
Rnd 5: *sc in next 4, 2 sc in next st (36)
Rnd 6: *sc in next 5, 2 sc in next st (42)
Rnd 7: *sc in next 6, 2 sc in next st (48)
Rnd 8: *sc in next 7, 2 sc in next st (54)
End with a slpst, leave long end for sewing it to the back of the blossom. Stuff as your work progresses

Soil
use brown yarn
chain 2
6 sc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ from hook (don`t pull the stitches too tight, the wire has to go through the whole in the middle)
Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)
Rnd 2: *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18)
Rnd 3: *sc in next 2, 2 sc in next st (24)
Rnd 4: *sc in next 3, 2 sc in next st (30)
Rnd 5: *sc in next 4, 2 sc in next st (36)
Rnd 6: *sc in next 5, 2 sc in next st (42)
Rnd 7: *sc in next 6, 2 sc in next st (48)
end with a slpst

## Pot

use light brown yarn
chain 2
6 sc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ from hook
Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)
Rnd 2: *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18)
Rnd 3: *sc in next 2, 2 sc in next st (24)
Rnd 4: *sc in next 3, 2 sc in next st (30)
Rnd 5: *sc in next 4, 2 sc in next st (36)
Rnd 6: *sc in next 5, 2 sc in next st (42)
Cut out a piece of cardboard/plastic
congruent with the piece you just crocheted
Rnd 7: *sc in back loops
Rnds 8-12: *sc around
Rnd 13: *sc in next 6,2 sc in next $\operatorname{st}(48)$
Rnds 14-16: * sc around
Rnd 17: * chain 3, 1 sc
End with a slpst, trim pot and press cardboard/plastic disc onto the bottom


Put wire through the middle of the soil and sew caulis to soil.
Push the wire to the top inside caulis to make the flower stand upright, form a ring and sew to soil. At this point the wire should be a bit under tension.
Form a spiral and push it into the pot. Sew soil to round 16 of the pot. Insert rice/stones as your work progresses.


## Pumpkin pot for Zombieflower

use orange yarn
chain 2
6 sc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ from hook
Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)
Rnd 2: *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18)
Rnd 3: *sc in next 2, 2 sc in next st (24)
Rnd 4: *sc in next 3, 2 sc in next st (30)
Rnd 5: *sc in next 4, 2 sc in next st (36)
Rnd 6: *sc in next 5, 2 sc in next st (42)
Rnd 7: *sc in next 6, 2 sc in next st (48)
Cut out a piece of cardboard/plastic
congruent with the piece you just crocheted
Rnds 8-9: *sc
Rnd 10: *sc in next 7, 2 sc in next st (54)
Rnds 11-16: *sc
Rnd 17: *sc in next 7, sc2tog (48)
Rnd 18: *sc in next 6, sc2tog (42)
Rnd 19: *sc in next 5, sc2tog (36)
Rnd 20: *sc in next 4, sc2tog (30)
end with a slpst and leave long end for
sewing
Soil
use brown yarn
chain 2


6 sc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ from hook
Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)
Rnd 2: *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18)
Rnd 3: *sc in next 2, 2 sc in next st (24)
Rnd 4: *sc in next 3, 2 sc in next st (30)

## Eyes

## use red yarn

chain 2
6 sc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ from hook
Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)

## Mouth

## use black yarn

chain 10, turn
Row 1: 1 slpst, 7 sc, 1 slpst (9)
Row 2: 1 slpst, sc2tog, 3 sc, sc2tog, 1 slpst (7)
Row 3: 1 slpst, sc2tog, 1 sc, sc2tog, 1 slpst (5)
fasten off and use white yarn to embroider teeth

## Twines

use green yarn and chain 20-30 or until you reach the desired length Row 1: *sc
