Abbreviations & Materials

sc = single crochet slpst = slipstitch * = repeat until end of round/row you need 8mm glass eyes I recommend to use Schachenmayr Catania + 2,5mm hook. I used black, blue and color #130 for the skin () = number of stitches

Head (starting at the top)

use beige yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2nd from hook

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 2: *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18)

Rnd 3: *sc in next 2, 2 sc in next st (24)

Rnd 4: *sc in next 3, 2 sc in next st (30)

Rnd 5: *sc in next 4, 2 sc in next st (36)

Rnds 6-11: * sc around

Rnd 12: *sc in next 4, sc2tog (30)

Rnd 13: *sc in next 3, sc2tog (24)

Rnds 14-15: * sc around

start stuffing the head

Rnd 16: *sc in next 2, sc2tog (18)

Rnd 17: *sc in next st, sc2tog (12)

Rnd 18: sc2tog around

cut yarn and pull it through the last loop. Weave tail through front loops and pull tight to close. Leave long end to sew to body

Legs (make 2) & Body

use black yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2nd from hook

Rnd 1: *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (9)

Rnd 2: * sc in back loops

Rnds 3-9: * sc around end 1st leg with a slpst

join the legs with 2 sc and continue working around both

Rnd 10: * sc around (16) stuff as your work progresses

Rnd 11: 4 sc, 2 sc in next st, 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc, 3 sc (18)

Rnd 12: *sc in next 2, 2 sc in next st (24)

Rnds 13-20: * sc around

Rnd 21: *sc in next 2, sc2tog (18)

Rnd 22: *sc in next st, sc2tog (12)

Rnd 23: sc2tog around

cut yarn and pull it through the last loop. Weave tail through front loops and pull tight to close.

Shoes (make 2)

use black yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2nd from hook

Rnd 1: *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (9)

Rnds 2-6: * sc around

Rnd 7: *sc in next st, sc2tog (6)

end with a slpst, cut yarn and pull it through the last loop. Weave tail through front loops and pull tight to close. Flatten shoes.

Arms (make 2)

use beige yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2nd from hook

Rnd 1: *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (9)

Rnds 2-3: * sc around change to black yarn

Pnds 4 10: * sc around

Rnds 4-10: * sc around

End with a slpst, leave longs ends for sewing

Wig

This part requires a bit more patience;-). To skip a strand means you just hold the strands of the last round away from you and insert the hook into the next stitch. While skipping a strand you may have to pull the yarn a bit more tightly than usual. Use only the stitches between the strands.

use black yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2nd from hook

Rnd 1: * chain 8, 7 sc, 2 sc in next st

Rnd 2: * skip 1 strand, 1 sc, chain 8, 7 sc, 2

sc in next st

Rnd 3: * skip 1 strand, 2 sc, chain 8, 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc

Rnd 4: * skip 1 strand, 3 sc, chain 8, 7 sc, 2 sc in next st

Rnd 5: * skip 1 strand, 1 sc, chain 8, 7 sc, 2 sc, chain 8, 7 sc, 1 sc, 2 sc in next st

Rnd 6: * skip 1 strand, 1 sc, chain 8, 7 sc, 2 sc, skip 1 strand, 2 sc

Rnd 7: * skip 1 strand, 2 sc, chain 8, 7 sc, 3 sc

end with a slpst and leave long end for sewing



Sew body parts together. There should be 10 stitches between the arms on the back of the body

Coat (back side)

check the size of the coat while you re working on it, maybe you have to adjust it

use black yarn

chain 11

Rows 1-4: *sc

Row 5: 4 sc, 2 sc in next st, 5 sc Row 6: 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc, 6sc Row 7: 3 sc, 2 sc in next st, 8 sc Row 8: 3 sc, 2 sc in next st, 9 sc

Rows 9-10: *sc

Row 11: 3 sc, 2 sc in next st, 10sc **Row 12:** 3 sc, 2 sc in next st, 11 sc

Rows 13-15: *sc

Coat (front side, make 2)

use black yarn

chain 7

Row 1: *sc Row 2: 4 sc Rows 3-5: *sc

Row 6: 4 sc, chain 3

Row 7: 6 sc Rows 8-10: *sc

Row 11: 2 sc, 2 sc in next st, 3 sc

Rows 12-15: *sc



sew pieces together

Sleeves (make 2)

use black yarn chain 14 and join with a slpst to form a ring **Rows 1-8:** *sc end with a slpst and sew to coat

Collar

use black yarn

join with an slpst to top of the coat

Row 1: 3 sc in first st, *sc, 3 sc in last st Row 2: 3 sc in first st, *sc, 3 sc in last st

Row 3: 2 sc in first st, 2 sc in next st, *sc, 2 sc in next to last st, 2 sc in last st Row 4: 2 sc in first st, 2 sc in next st, *sc, 2 sc in next to last st, 2 sc in last st

chain 1 and fasten off

Scarf

use blue yarn chain 4 and work sc in rows until the scarf has reached the desired length, add fringe

Add glass eyes, embroider mouth and the red button hole
