### Abbreviations & Material

sc = single crochet
\* = repeat until end of round/row
( ) = number of stitches

- glass eyes, 7mm in diameter
- polyfill
- piece of strong cardboard or plastic, 5 x 5 cm (if you want your chicken to stand upright
- yarn in brown, red, yellow, white (I recommend to use Schachenmayr Catania + 2,5mm hook)

Head

use brown yarn chain 2 6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> from hook Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12) Rnd 2: \*sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18) **Rnd 3**: \*sc in next 2, 2 sc in next st (24) **Rnd 4:** \*sc in next 3, 2 sc in next st (30) **Rnd 5:** \*sc in next 4, 2 sc in next st (36) Rnds 6-10: \* sc Rnd 11: \*sc in next 4, sc2tog (30) start stuffing the body Rnd 12: \*sc in next 3, sc2tog (24) Rnd 13: \*sc in next 2, sc2tog (18) **Rnd 14:** \*sc in next, sc2tog (12) Rnd 15: sc2tog around (6) cut yarn and pull it through the last loop. Weave tail through front loops an d pull tight to close.

Wings (make 2)

use brown yarn chain 2 6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> from hook **Rnd 1:** 2 sc in each st around (12) **Rnds 2-8:** \* sc chain 1, flatten wing, 3 sc through both layers, bind off



Eyes (make 2)

use white yarn chain 2 6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> from hook **Rnd 1:** 2 sc in each st around (12) **Rnds 2-3:** \* sc end with a slipstitch and stuff

Eyelids

use brown yarn **Row 1:** chain 8, turn **Rows 2–3:** \* sc chain 1 and bind off

## Body

use brown yarn chain 2 6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> from hook **Rnd 1:** 2 sc in each st around (12) **Rnd 2:** \*sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18) **Rnd 3:** \*sc in next 2, 2 sc in next st (24) **Rnd 4:** \*sc in next 3, 2 sc in next st (30) Cut out a piece of cardboard/plastic congruent with the piece you just crocheted. **Rnd 5 (in back loops):** \*sc in next 4, 2 sc in next st (36)

**Rnd 6:** \*sc in next 5, 2 sc in next st (42) **Rnd 7:** \*sc in next 6, 2 sc in next st (48) **Rnd 8:** \*sc in next 7, 2 sc in next st (54) **Rnd 9:** \*sc in next 8, 2 sc in next st (60) **Rds 10-18:** \* sc **Rnd 19:** 1 sc, join  $1^{st}$  wing with 6 sc, 24 sc, join  $2^{nd}$  wing with 6 sc, 23 sc

Put the cardboard piece onto the ground of the body and secure. Start stuffing.





Rnd 20: \*sc in next 8, sc2tog (54) Rnd 21: \*sc in next 7, sc2tog (48) Rnd 22: \*sc in next 6, sc2tog (42) Rnd 23: \*sc in next 5, sc2tog (36) Rnd 24: \*sc in next 4, sc2tog (30) Rnd 25 \*sc in next 3, sc2tog (24) Rnd 26: \*sc in next 2, sc2tog (18) Rnd 27: \*sc in next, sc2tog (12) Rnd 28: sc2tog around (6) cut yarn and pull it through the last loop. Weave tail through front loops an d pull tight to close.



### Jowls (make 2)

use red yarn chain 2 6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> from hook **Rnd 1:** 2 sc in each st around (12) **Rnd 2:** chain 1, turn, 3 sc, chain 1, bind off and sew to beak

### Comb

Tips (make 3)

use red yarn chain 2 6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> from hook **Rnd 1:** \*sc (6) **Rnd 2:** \*sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (9) **Rnd 3-4:** \*sc end with a slipstitch Don't bind off after the 3<sup>rd</sup> tip. Join the next tip with a slipstitch. 3 sc into 2<sup>nd</sup> tip join last tip with a slipstitch continue working around all tips – work 2 rounds sc – \*sc in next 3, sc2tog bind off and stuff



Tail Feathers (make 3)

use brown yarn chain 2 6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> from hook **Rnd 1:** \*sc (6) **Rnd 2:** \*sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (9) **Rnds 3-7:** \*sc **Rnd 8:** 1 sc, sc2tog, 6 sc (8) **Rnd 9:** \*sc **Rnd 10:** 1 sc, sc2tog, 5 sc (7) **Rnd 11:** 1 sc, sc2tog, 4 sc (6) end with a slipstitch



#### Beak

use yellow yarn chain 2 6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> from hook **Rnd 1:** \*sc (6) **Rnd 2:** \*sc **Rnd 3:** \*sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (9) **Rnd 4:** \*sc **Rnd 5:** \*sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (12) **Rnd 6:** \*sc end with a slipstitch sew body parts together
