## Abbreviations & Material

sc = single crochet

\* = repeat until end of round/row

( ) = number of stitches

sc = single crochet

slpst = slipstitch

- poly fill
- strong wire for legs & wings (3-4mm)
- black glass eyes, 10cm in diameter
- Schachenmayr Catania in red, black, white, orange
- 2,5 mm hook (Feathers McGraw is about 22cm high)

## Head & Body (starting at the head)

use black yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> from hook

**Rnd 1:** 2 sc in each st around (12)

**Rnd 2:** \*sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18)

**Rnd 3:** \*sc in next 2, 2 sc in next st (24)

**Rnd 4:** \*sc in next 3, 2 sc in next st (30)

**Rnd 5:** \*sc in next 4, 2 sc in next st (36)

**Rnds 6-28:** sc around

**Rnd 29:** \*sc in next 5, 2 sc in next st (42)

**Rnd 30:** sc around

**Rnd 31:** \*sc in next 6, 2 sc in next st (48)

**Rnd 32:** sc around

**Rnd 33:** \*sc in next 7, 2 sc in next st (54)

**Rnd 34:** sc around

**Rnd 35:** \*sc in next 8, 2 sc in next st (60)

**Rnd 36:** sc around

**Rnd 37:** \*sc in next 9, 2 sc in next st (66)

**Rnds 38-53:** sc around

**Rnd 54:** \*sc in next 9, sc2tog (60)

**Rnd 55:** \*sc in next 8, sc2tog (54)

**Rnd 56:** \*sc in next 7, sc2tog (48)

**Rnd 57:** \*sc in next 6, sc2tog (42)

**Rnd 58:** \*sc in next 5, sc2tog (36)

**Rnd 59:** \*sc in next 4, sc2tog (30)

**Rnd 60:** \*sc in next 3, sc2tog (24)

**Rnd 61:** \*sc in next 2, sc2tog (18)

**Rnd 62:** \*sc in next, sc2tog (12)

**Rnd 63:** sc2tog around (6)

cut yarn and pull it through the last loop. Weave tail through front loops and pull tight to close.

## Feet (make 2)

use orange yarn

chain 2

4 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> from hook

**Rnd 1:** 2 sc in each st around (8)

**Rnd 2:** \*sc in next 3, 2 sc in next st (10)

**Rnd 3:** \*sc in next 4, 2 sc in next st (12)

**Rnd 4:** \*sc in next 5, 2 sc in next st (14)

**Rnd 5:** \*sc in next 6, 2 sc in next st (16)

**Rnd 6:** \*sc in next 7, 2 sc in next st (18)

**Rnd 7:** \*sc in next 8, 2 sc in next st (20)

**Rnd 8:** \*sc in next 9, 2 sc in next st (22)

**Rnd 9:** \*sc in next 10, 2 sc in next st (24)

**Rnd 10:** \*sc in next 11, 2 sc in next st (26)

**Rnd 11:** \*sc in next 12, 2 sc in next st (28), End with a slpst, leave long end for sewing

## Legs (make 2)

use orange yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> from hook

**Rnd 1:** \*sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (9)

**Rnds 2-8:** sc around

End with a slpst, leave long end for sewing

## Beak

use orange yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> from hook

**Rnd 1:** sc around

**Rnd 2:** 2 sc in each st around (12)

**Rnd 3:** sc around

**Rnd 4:** \*sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18)

**Rnd 5:** sc around

**Rnd 6:** \*sc in next 2, 2 sc in next st (24)

End with a slpst, leave long end for sewing and stuff

## Tummy

use white yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> from hook

**Rnd 1:** 2 sc in each st around (12)

**Rnd 2:** \*sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18)

**Rnd 3:** \*sc in next 2, 2 sc in next st (24)

**Rnd 4:** \*sc in next 3, 2 sc in next st (30)

**Rnd 5:** \*sc in next 4, 2 sc in next st (36)

**Rnd 6:** \*sc in next 5, 2 sc in next st (42)

[continue working in rows](#)

**Row 7:** 14 sc, 1 slpst, turn

**Row 8:** 12 sc, 1 slpst, turn

**Row 9:** 1 slpst, 4 sc, 2 in next st, 4 sc, 1 slpst, turn

**Row 10:** 1 slpst, 3 sc, 2 in next st, 3 sc, 5 slpst, turn

[work in rounds](#)

**Rnd 11:** \*sc in next 3, 2 sc in next st

**Rnd 12:** \*sc in next 4, 2 sc in next st

End with a slpst, leave long end for sewing

## Wings (make 2)

use black yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> from hook

**Rnd 1:** 2 sc in each st around (12)

**Rnd 2:** \*sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18)

**Rnds 3-18:** sc around

**Rnd 19:** \*sc in next, sc2tog (12)

[Insert wire and push to the edges](#)

flatten wings and work sc through both layers, end with a slpst and leave long end for sewing

## Hat/Glove

### Fingers (make 4)

use red yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> from hook

**Rnds 1-6:** sc around

chain 1 and bind off

**Rnd 7:** do not bind off the last one, join the 2<sup>nd</sup> finger with 1 sc, 2 sc into 2<sup>nd</sup> finger, join 3<sup>rd</sup> finger with 1 sc, 2 sc into 3<sup>rd</sup> finger

join 4<sup>th</sup> finger with 1 sc, 5 sc around the 4<sup>th</sup> one

work sc along the other side until round ends (24)

**Rnd 8:** \*sc in next 3, 2 sc in next st (30)

**Rnd 9:** \*sc in next 4, 2 sc in next st (36)

**Rnd 10:** \*sc in next 6, 2 sc in next st (41)

**Rnds 11-17:** sc around

**Rnd 18:** sc around in front loops only

**Runde 19:** sc around

End with a slpst, fold rounds 18+19 to the outside and secure

Bend the wire



Force the upper end through a stitch



Insert into foot and sew foot together



Put leg over wire (last round to the top), stuff a bit and sew to foot



Leave 1-2cm of wire on top of the leg and stuff into body for more stability. Check if he can stand on his legs and sew them to body. Sew the rest of the body parts together.
