Abbreviations & Material

sc = single crochet
* = repeat until end of round/row
() = number of stitches
sc = single crochet
slpst = slipstitch
hdc = half double crochet

- poly fill
- 2 black glass eyes, 6mm in diameter
- Schachenmayr Catania
- 2,5 mm hook

Head

use orange yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2nd from hook

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 2: *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18)

Rnds 3-4: sc around

Rnd 5: *sc in next 2, 2 sc in next st (24)

Rnd 6: *sc in next 3, 2 sc in next st (30)

Rnd 7: *sc in next 4, 2 sc in next st (36)

Rnds 8-12: sc around

Rnd 13: *sc in next 4, sc2tog (30)

Rnd 14: *sc in next 3, sc2tog (24)

Rnd 15: *sc in next 2, sc2tog (18)

Rnd 16: *sc in next, sc2tog (12)

Rnd 17: sc2tog around (6)

cut yarn and pull it through the last loop. Weave tail through front loops and pull tight to close, embroider nose.

Body

use orange yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2nd from hook

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 2: *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18)

Rnd 3: *sc in next 2, 2 sc in next st (24)

Rnds 4-6: sc around

Rnd 7: *sc in next 3, 2 sc in next st (30)

Rnd 8: *sc in next 4, 2 sc in next st (36)

Rnds 9-10: sc around

Rnd 11: *sc in next 4, sc2tog (30)

Rnd 12: *sc in next 3, sc2tog (24)

Rnd 13: *sc in next 2, sc2tog (18)

Rnd 14: *sc in next, sc2tog (12)

Rnd 15: sc2tog around (6)

cut yarn and pull it through the last loop. Weave tail through front loops and pull tight to close

Ears (make 2)

use orange yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2nd from hook

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)

Rnds 2-7: sc around

Rnd 8: *sc in next 4, sc2tog (10)

Rnd 9: sc around

Rnd 10: *sc in next 3, sc2tog (8)

Rnd 11: sc around

End with a slpst, leave long end for sewing

Eyes (make 2)

use white yarn

chain 2

10 hdc in 2nd from hook

End with a slpst, leave long end for sewing

Eyelids (make 2)

use orange yarn

Row 1: chain 4, turn

Row 2: 2 sc in next st, 1 sc, 2 sc in next st (5)

Row 3: 2 sc in next st, 2 sc, 2 sc in next st (7)

chain 1 and bind off, leave long end for sewing

Tail

use orange yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2nd from hook

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)

Rnds 2-3: sc around

End with a slpst, leave long end for sewing

Legs (make 2)

use orange yarn

chain 5

Rnd 1: 3 sc, 4 sc in last st (work around the last st), 2 sc, 2 sc in last st (11)

Rnd 2: 4 sc, 2 x (2 st in next st), 4 sc, 2 sc in next st (14)

Rnds 3-4: sc around

Rnd 5: 4 sc, 2 x sc2tog, 6 sc (12)

Rnd 6: 3 fm, 2 x sc2tog, 4 sc (10)

Rnds 7-9: sc around

End with a slpst, leave long end for sewing, stuff.

Arms (make 2)

use orange yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2nd from hook

Rnd 1: *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (9)

Rnds 2-8: sc around

End with a slpst, leave long end for sewing, stuff.

Mouth

use black or brown yarn

chain 9

Row 1: sc2tog, 4 sc, sc2tog (6)

Row 2: sc2tog, 2 sc, sc2tog (4)

chain 1 and bind off, leave long end for sewing, embroider teeth

Eggs

use yarn in the colour of your choice

chain 2

6 sc in 2nd from hook (change yarn colour with every round to get striped eggs)

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 2: *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18)

Rnds 3-5: sc around

stuff as your work progresses

Rnd 6: *sc in next, sc2tog (12)

Rnds 7-8: sc around

Rnd 9: sc2tog around (6)

cut yarn and pull it through the last loop. Weave tail through front loops and pull tight to close. Trim or embroider eggs as you like.

Put body parts together. Take care while sewing legs and tail to body so he can sit without any further help. Use orange yarn to sew one egg to each leg and connect the eggs.
