

Sherlock Lip Balm Cosy

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Abbreviations & Material

sc = single crochet

* = repeat until end of round/row

() = number of stitches

sc = single crochet

slpst = slipstitch

Sherlock fits perfectly on the usual approx. 6,5 x 2 cm lipbalm.
I used a 2,5mm hook and Schachenmayr Catania.



Part 1

(should fit the cover tightly, can be adjusted)

use black yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2nd from hook

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 2: *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18)

Rnd 3: *sc in backloops only

sew loose end on the inside

Rnds 4-21: sc around

Rnd 22: (in front loops only) 16 sc, chain 1, turn

Row 23: 2 sc in next st, 14 sc, 2 hdc in last st, chain 1 and fasten off, sew loose ends, fold collar down and embroider button hole.

Part 2

use skin coloured yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2nd from hook

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 2: *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18)

sew loose end on the inside

Rnds 3-9: sc around

end with a slpst, leave end for sewing

Wig

This part requires a bit more patience ;-). To skip a strand means you just hold the strands of the last round away from you and insert the hook into the next stitch. While skipping a strand you may have to pull the yarn a bit more tightly than usual. Use only the stitches between the strands.

use brown yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2nd from hook

Rnd 1: * chain 5, 4 sc, 1 sc in next st, chain 5, 4 sc, 1 sc in same st (12)

Rnd 2: * chain 5, 4 sc, skip 1 Strand, 1 sc, chain 5, 4 sc, 2 sc in next st (18)



Rnd 3: sc around, end with a slpst, leave end for sewing.

Embroider face and sew wig to head.

Sew both parts together with 3 stitches so you can open Sherlock's head to the back.
