USB flash drive bunny

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Materials

(use Schachenmayr Catania in this pattern + 2,5mm hook, every other yarn might not work)

- brown yarn
- leftovers of light brown, white, orange and green yarn
- glass eyes, 6mm in diameter
- USB flash drive by Corsair
- tapestry needle and 1 very thin needle
- maybe you need a gripper to force the needle through the casing of the flash device
- twine (orange, brown, white, red, black)

Abbreviations:

sc = single crochet slpst = slipstitch () = number of stitches

* = repeat until end of round/row

Carrot & Greens



Starting at the tip Use orange yarn chain 2

6 sc in 2nd from hook

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12) continue working around, increasing 2 stitches per round, one stitch at the beginning and one on the opposite side. Check regularly if carrot fits onto the cap. You might have to increase more ore less stitches depending on how tight your stitches are.

Continue until carrot reaches the red line. Sc around until you reach the end of the cap. Fasten off

use green yarn slpst into the tip of the carrot * chain as many stitches as you please (5-

30), turn and work sc back to the tip Maybe you want to crochet one strand long enough to reach Bunny's paw so you can't loose the cap.

Use the thin needle to sew carrot on the cap. Secure with a little bit of superglue.

Arms (2x)

use light brown yarn chain 2

6 sc in 2nd from hook

Rnd 1: *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (9)

Rnds 2-3: *sc around change to brown yarn Rnds 4-10: * sc around

end with a slpst

stuff arms

Head and Body

chain 14 and join to form a ring. This ring should fit perfectly around the drive where the red line is. Don't worry if you need 2 stitches more or less, just continue with the pattern. Work around the ring in rounds

Rnd 1: * sc around

Rnd 2: *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st Rnd 3: *sc in next 2, 2 sc in next st Rnd 4: *sc in next 3, 2 sc in next st

Rnds 5-12: * sc around Rnd 13: *sc in next 3, sc2tog

Insert flash drive into head and sew mouth to casing as shown on the picture below. Start stuffing the head tightly as your work progresses. Use superglue to secure.

Rnd 14: *sc in next 2, sc2tog Rnd 15: *sc in next 2, sc2tog

Rnd 16: *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st Rnd 17: *sc in next 7, 2 sc in next st

Rnds 18-26: * sc around Rnd 27: *sc in next 3, sc2tog Rnd 28: *sc in next 2, sc2tog Rnd 29: *sc in next st, sc2tog Rnd 30: sc2tog around

cut yarn and pull it through the last loop. Weave tail through front loops and pull tight

to close.





Legs (2x)

use light brown yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2nd from hook

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 2: * sc around

Rnd 3: 3 x sc2tog, * sc (9) change to brown yarn Rnds 4-10: * sc around

end with a slpst and stuff

Ears (2x)

use brown yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2nd from hook

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)

Rnds 2-10: * sc around

Rnd 11: * sc in next 3, sc2tog

Rnd 12: * sc around

Rnd 13: * sc in next 2, sc2tog

Rnd 14: * sc around

Eyes (2x)

use white yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2nd from hook

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)

Rnds 2-3: * sc around

Tail

use brown yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2nd from hook

Rnd 1: *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (9)

Rnds 2-3: * sc around

Pin arms and legs to body, check if bunny is lying comfortable on his belly and sew parts together. Embroider red eyes and nose.
