This flower is inspired by the "Calming plant" from the app Zombiesrungame and it`s suitable to repel zombies ^^

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#### **Abbreviations & Material**

sc = single crochet
slpst = slipstitch
\* = repeat until end of round/row
( ) = number of stitches

- strong wire, 30-40 cm long
- piece of cardboard, 10 x 10 cm
- Schachenmayr Catania in black, green, bright grey, brown, blue(#0146)
- 2,5mm hook
- tapestry needle
- flower pot, approx. 7cm in diameter hot glue



### Leaves (make 2)

use green yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> from hook

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)

**Rnd 2:** \*sc

Rnd 3: \*sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18)

Rnds 4-10: \*sc

**Rnd 11:** \*sc in next st, sc2tog (12)

Rnds 12-13: \*sc

bend wire and insert into leaf **Rnd 14:** \*sc2tog around (6)

Rnd 15: \*sc

end with a slpst, leave end for sewing



#### Caulis

use green yarn, leave long end for sewing

Chain 6 and join together to form a ring, continue working in rounds

Rnds 1-25: \*sc

Rnd 26: 2 sc in each st around (12)

**Rnd 27:** \*sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18)

Rnd 28: \*sc in next 2, 2 sc in next st (24)

Rnd 29: \*sc in next 3, 2 sc in next st (30)

Rnd 30: \*sc in next 4, 2 sc in next st (36)

End with a slpst, bind off and leave long end for sewing. Insert wire into the caulis, form a ring at the top and sew to rounds 27-30. Leave end of the wire at the bottom of the caulis.



## Petals (make 8)

1 of the petals needs a long end at the beginning and the end

use blue yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> from hook

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)

Rnds 2-4: \*sc

**Rnd 5:** 1 sc, sc2tog, 9sc (11)

Rnd 6: 5 sc, sc2tog, 4 sc (10)

Rnd 7: 1 sc, sc2tog, 7sc (9) change to grey yarn Rnd 8: 5 sc, sc2tog, 2 sc (8) change to black yarn

**Rnd 9:** 1 sc, sc2tog, 5 sc (7) **Rnd 10:** 3 sc, sc2tog, 2 sc (6)

fasten off

Arrange petals and sew centre together using black yarn. Press into conic shape to close possible gap in the middle.





Use blue yarn for another round of sewing. Sew blossom to caulis.

Cut out a cardboard circle that fits into the pot approx. 1cm below the edge.

#### Soil

Soil should be congruent with the cardboard circle, adjust if necessary.

use brown yarn

chain 2

6 sc in  $2^{nd}$  from hook (don't pull the stitches too tight, the wire has to go through the whole in the middle)

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 2: \*sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18)

**Rnd 3:** \*sc in next 2, 2 sc in next st (24)

**Rnd 4:** \*sc in next 3, 2 sc in next st (30)

**Rnd 5:** \*sc in next 4, 2 sc in next st (36)

Rnd 6: \*sc in next 5, 2 sc in next st (42)

**Rnd 7:** \*sc in next 6, 2 sc in next st (48)

end with a slpst

Put wire through the middle of the soil and sew caulis to soil.

Push the wire to the top inside caulis to make the flower stand upright, form a ring and sew to cardboard (through cardboard + soil). Sew leaves to soil and bend as you please. Attach flower to pot using hot glue.
