# Door monkey

#### **Abbreviations & Material**

sc = single crochet

\* = repeat until end of round/row

() = number of stitches

sc = single crochet

slpst = slipstitch

- poly fill
- strong wire for legs (3-4mm)

Pablo is approx. 30cm tall (without legs) if you use a 4-5mm hook. His arms are also 30cm long.

#### Head

use dark brown yarn

Rnd 32: \*sc in next 4, sc2tog (30) Rnd 33: \*sc in next 3, sc2tog (24) Rnd 34: \*sc in next 2, sc2tog (18) Rnd 35: \*sc in next, sc2tog (12) Rnd 36: sc2tog around (6)

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chain 2
6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> from hook
Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)
Rnd 2: *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18)
Rnd 3: *sc in next 2, 2 sc in next st (24)
Rnd 4: *sc in next 3, 2 sc in next st (30)
Rnd 5: *sc in next 4, 2 sc in next st (36)
Rnd 6: *sc in next 5, 2 sc in next st (42)
Rnd 7: *sc in next 6, 2 sc in next st (48)
Rnd 8: *sc in next 7, 2 sc in next st (54)
Rnd 9: *sc in next 8, 2 sc in next st (60)
Rnds 10-21: sc around
Rnd 22: *sc in next 8, sc2tog (54)
Rnd 23: *sc in next 7, sc2tog (48)
Rnd 24: *sc in next 6, sc2tog (42)
Rnd 25: *sc in next 5, sc2tog (36)
Rnd 26: *sc in next 4, sc2tog (30)
Rnd 27: *sc in next 3, sc2tog (24)
Rnd 28: *sc in next 2, sc2tog (18)
Rnd 29: *sc in next, sc2tog (12)
Rnd 30: sc2tog around (6)
cut yarn and pull it through the last loop. Weave tail through front loops and pull tight to
close. Leave long end for sewing.
Body (starting at the top)
use dark brown yarn
chain 2
6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> from hook
Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)
Rnd 2: *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18)
Rnd 3: *sc in next 2, 2 sc in next st (24)
Rnd 4: *sc in next 3, 2 sc in next st (30)
Rnd 5: *sc in next 4, 2 sc in next st (36)
Rnd 6: *sc in next 5, 2 sc in next st (42)
Rnd 7: *sc in next 6, 2 sc in next st (48)
Rnds 8-15: sc around
Rnd 16: *sc in next 7, 2 sc in next st (54)
Rnds 17-28: sc around
Rnd 29: *sc in next 7, sc2tog (48)
Rnd 30: *sc in next 6, sc2tog (42)
Rnd 31: *sc in next 5, sc2tog (36)
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cut yarn and pull it through the last loop. Weave tail through front loops an d pull tight to close.

#### Eyes (make 2)

use light brown yarn chain 2

6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> from hook

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 2: \*sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18)

Rnd 3: \*sc in next 2, 2 sc in next st (24)

Rnd 4: \*sc in next 3, 2 sc in next st (30) end with a slpst and leave long end for

sewing



#### Pupils (make 2)

use black yarn chain 2

6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> from hook, end with a slpst and sew onto eyes

#### Snout

use light brown yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> from hook

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 2: \*sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18)

**Rnd 3**: \*sc in next 2, 2 sc in next st (24)

Rnd 4: \*sc in next 3, 2 sc in next st (30)

**Rnd 5:** \*sc in next 4, 2 sc in next st (36)

**Rnd 6:** \*sc in next 5, 2 sc in next st (42)

Rnds 7-10: sc around

end with a slpst and leave long end for sewing

#### Ears (make 2)

use dark brown yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> from hook

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 2: \*sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18)

**Rnd 3**: \*sc in next 2, 2 sc in next st (24)

Rnds 4-8: sc around

end with a slpst and leave long end for sewing

Arms (make 2)

use light brown yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> from hook

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)

**Rnd 2:** \*sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18) **Rnd 3:** \*sc in next 2, 2 sc in next st (24)

Rnds 4-8: sc around

change to dark brown yarn

**Rnds 9-50** (or until you reach the desired length): sc around end with a slpst and leave long end for sewing, stuff

### Feet (make 2)

chain 11 and continue working around these

**Rnd 1:** 9 sc, 4 sc in last st, 9 sc

Rnds 2-6: \* sc around mark round 6

Rnds 7-19: \* sc around

flatten the foot and sew together between rnd 6 and 7 through both layers, embroider toes and stuff foot

Rnd 20: \*sc in next 2, sc2tog (18) Rnd 21: \*sc in next, sc2tog (12) Rnd 22: sc2tog around (6)



cut yarn and pull it through the last loop. Weave tail through front loops an d pull tight to close.

## Legs (make 2)

use dark brown yarn
chain 23 and join with a slpst to form a ring
continue working in rounds
Rnds 1-25: \* sc around
end with a slpst and leave long end for sewing

Sew body parts together, embroider mouth and nose. Insert wire into legs and stuff. Sew feet to legs and legs to body. Chain as many as you need to hang arms onto the door handle and tie ends to the inside of the hands. Bend legs so they look like monkey legs and feet towards the door for more stability.
