Abbreviations & Material

sc = single crochet

* = repeat until end of round/row

() = number of stitches

sc = single crochet

slpst = slipstitch

dc = double crochet

- poly fill
- 2 black glass eyes, 9mm in diameter
- yarn in white and the colour of your choice for hat and scarf (I used Schachenmayr Catania for the body)

Head (starting at the snout)

use white yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2nd from hook

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 2: *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18)

Rnd 3: sc around

Rnd 4: *sc in next 2, 2 sc in next st (24)

Rnd 5: sc around

Rnd 6: *sc in next 3, 2 sc in next st (30)

Rnd 7: sc around

Rnd 8: *sc in next 4, 2 sc in next st (36)

Rnd 9: sc around

Rnd 10: *sc in next 5, 2 sc in next st (42)

Rnd 11: *sc in next 6, 2 sc in next st (48)

Rnd 12: *sc in next 7, 2 sc in next st (54)

Rnds 13-17: sc around

Rnd 18: *sc in next 7, sc2tog (48)

Rnd 19: *sc in next 6, sc2tog (42)

Rnd 20: *sc in next 5, sc2tog (36)

Rnd 21: *sc in next 4, sc2tog (30)

start stuffing

Rnd 22: *sc in next 3, sc2tog (24)

Rnd 23: *sc in next 2, sc2tog (18)

Rnd 24: *sc in next, sc2tog (12)

Rnd 25: sc2tog around (6)

cut yarn and pull it through the last loop. Weave tail through front loops and pull tight to close. Use black yarn to embroider snout and mouth

Body (starting at the top)

use white yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2nd from hook

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 2: *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18)

Rnd 3: *sc in next 2, 2 sc in next st (24)

Rnd 4: *sc in next 3, 2 sc in next st (30)

Rnd 5: *sc in next 4, 2 sc in next st (36)

Rnd 6: *sc in next 5, 2 sc in next st (42)

Rnd 7: *sc in next 6, 2 sc in next st (48)

Rnds 8-18: sc around

Rnd 19: *sc in next 6, sc2tog (42)

Rnd 20: *sc in next 5, sc2tog (36)

Rnd 21: *sc in next 4, sc2tog (30)

start stuffing

Rnd 22: *sc in next 3, sc2tog (24)

Rnd 23: *sc in next 2, sc2tog (18)

Rnd 24: *sc in next, sc2tog (12)

Rnd 25: sc2tog around (6)

cut yarn and pull it through the last loop. Weave tail through front loops and pull tight to close.

Legs (make 2)

use white yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2nd from hook

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 2: *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18)

Rnds 3-4: sc around

Rnd 4: 1 sc, 6 x sc2tog, 5 sc (12)

Rnds 6-9: sc around

end with a slpst, leave long end for sewing, stuff, embroider paws

Arms (make 2)

use white yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2nd from hook

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)

Rnds 2-10: sc around

end with a slpst, leave long end for sewing, stuff

Tail

use white yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2nd from hook

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)

Rnds 2-3: sc around

end with a slpst, leave long end for sewing, stuff

Ears

use white yarn

chain 2

6 sc in 2nd from hook

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 2: *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18)

Rnds 3-5: sc around

Rnd 6: *sc in next, sc2tog (12)

end with a slpst, leave long end for sewing, do not stuff

Scarf

chain 6 and continue sc in rows until you reach the desired length, chain 1 to end, add fringe

Hat

use yarn in the colour of your choice

chain 2

6 sc in 2nd from hook

Rnds 1-2: sc around

Rnd 3: 2 sc in each st around (12)

Rnds 4-5: sc around

Rnd 6: *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st (18)

Rnds 7-8: sc around

Rnd 9: *sc in next 2, 2 sc in next st (24)

Rnds 10-11: sc around

Rnd 12: *sc in next 3, 2 sc in next st (30)

Rnds 13-14: sc around

end with a slpst, make a pompom with a fork ([pompom tutorial](#)) and sew to hat
